By simply browsing the Website you are consenting to the installation of the cookies of which we inform you in this “Cookie Policy” (unless you have modified your browser settings to reject them). What is a cookie? A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when you access certain websites. Cookies allow a website, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or its equipment and, depending on the information they contain and the way you use your computer, and they can be used to recognise the user. Cookies are essential for the functioning of the Internet; they cannot damage the user's computer/device and, if enabled in your browser settings, help to identify and resolve possible malfunctions of the Website. What types of cookies does IUS + AEQUITAS use and what is their purpose? Two types of cookies are installed on the Website, depending on their purpose: First-Party Cookies: these are those that are sent to the user's device from a computer or domain managed by the domain the user is visiting and from which the service requested by the user is provided. Third-party cookies: are those that are sent to the user's device from a computer or domain that is not managed by the domain the user is visiting, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies. The cookies that IUS + AEQUITAS uses on the Website are the following: § Analysis Cookies through Google Analytics, which is a web analytics tool that allows IUS + AEQUITAS to assess how users interact with its Website. IUS + AEQUITAS may consult various reports describing how Users interact with the Website for the purpose of improving the site. Google Analytics collects information anonymously, i.e. it reports site trends without identifying its users. How can I disable or delete cookies? The user can allow, block or delete cookies installed on your computer by configuring the browser settings enabled on your computer. You can change your privacy settings regarding the installation of cookies at any time, in your browser. These procedures are subject to update or modification by the developers of the browsers, so we cannot guarantee that they are completely in line with the latest version available at any given time. In the “Tools > Internet Options” menu, go to the “Privacy” tab, select it and click on the “Advanced” button. Check the “Override automatic cookie management” check box. Check the “Enable”, “Block” or “Ask” check box. We recommend activating the option “Always accept session cookies” to allow optimal navigation on our website. In the “Tools > Options” menu, go to the “Privacy” tab. Check or uncheck the “Tell websites I do not want to be tracked” check box. You can also delete installed cookies by clicking on the “Delete individual cookies” option. In the “Tools > Settings” menu, go to the “Privacy > Content settings” tab. If you do not wish to allow their installation, you can select the option “Block site data and third-party cookies”. In the

“Tools > Preferences” menu, go to the “Privacy” tab. In the “Block cookies” menu, select the “Always” or “Never” check box. In the Opera menu > Settings > Options > Advanced > Cookies. Choose your desired settings. Click on Accept.
