

1. The access and use of the Website implies the acceptance by the user of all the conditions included in this legal notice, which is made available on a permanent basis to the user in the Spanish language on the Website, and the user may file it, print it and, therefore, be previously informed of the general conditions of use of the website.

2. Conditions of use of the Website - 2.1 The user undertakes to make conscientious use of the Website, in full compliance with these Conditions and the legislation in force. The user will be liable to the law firm IUS + AEQUITAS or third parties for any damages that may be caused as a result of a breach of this obligation. 3.
